The objective of the meeting is to provide *Stata* users working in different research areas, with a unique opportunity to exchange ideas, experiences and information on new applications of the software. *Stata* users interested in contributing to the meeting are therefore encouraged to submit their proposals to the scientific committee. As in previous years, whilst the emphasis is on:

- ◆ the development of new commands or procedures currently unavailable in *Stata* 11;
- Proposals based on
- ◆ the use of *Stata* in previously unpublished empirical research;
 - ◆ other applications of *Stata* for the solution of problems of general interest: for example, data management, teaching; are also encouraged.

The first day of the meeting will be organised in 4 sessions. Each session will include 3 presentations of approximately 20 minutes, followed by 10 to 15 minutes of discussion. The first session will be reserved for an invited speaker. Two training courses will be organised on the second day of the meeting: the first, *Analisi dei Tempi di Sopravvivenza in Presenza di Rischi Competitivi*, will be given in Italian; the second, *Programming an Estimation Command in Stata and Mata*, in English. More detailed information regarding the training courses will be published on TStat's website by the end February 2010. A detailed programme of the meeting will be available on TStat's web by end of September.

Authors interested in presenting their work, are requested to submit an abstract in electronic format before **30.08.10** to the scientific committee at the following address:

statausers@tstat.it. The authors name, affiliation, and a telephone number should be included in the email. A preliminary selection will be made by the scientific committee, on the basis of submitted abstracts, by the **15.09.10**. The final version of the paper must be submitted to the conference organiser by the **28.10.10**.
